Create your hat at home and bring it along to the parade at 12 noon for judging

0-7 years – Your hat can be created on an existing hat as the base and add colourful and fun items connected to gardens or gardening, with a little surprise perhaps. You can use some greenery, flowers or vegies from your own garden or that of a friend or relative.

8-12 years – Your hat can be created on an existing hat as the base and add crazy items connected to gardens or gardening that will make us laugh. Use greenery, flowers and something edible from your own garden or that of a friend or relative.

13 years and adult – Your hat must be entirely made of plant material and items connected to gardens or gardening (no hat as a base for you!). Make your hat the most elegant and colourful using greenery, flowers and something edible from your own garden or that of a friend or relative.

The parade will take place at 12 noon in the Barn at the Country Paradise Parklands and a prizes will be awarded to the best one in each section as decided by the judges whose decision is final. Winners will be notified on the day and must be present to receive their prize. There will be no second or third prizes.
